### MUSEUM OF ISLAMIC ART

AThe Museum of Islamic Art (MIA) is a museum on one end of the seven-kilometer-long (4.3 mi) Corniche in Doha, Qatar. As per the architect I. M. Pei's specifications, the museum is built on an island off an artificial projecting peninsula near the traditional dhow harbor. A purpose-built park surrounds the edifice on the eastern and southern facades while two bridges connect the southern front facade of the property with the main peninsula that holds the park.[1] The western and northern facades are marked by the harbor showcasing the Qatari seafaring past. In September 2017, Qatar Museums appointed Julia Gonnella as new director of MIA.

### **FAQ on Visa Requirements**

#### Who can send the application for Qatar ETA online?

If you hold a residence permit or visa to any of the following countries, you may apply for an Electronic Travel Authorization and obtain a visa on arrival: Schengen countries, Australia, Canada, UK, USA or New Zealand.

In addition, proof of valid visitor visa held for any one of the following countries: Australia, Canada, GCC, New Zealand, and Schengen countries, USA or UK. Visa must be valid for at least 30 days after arrival from the date of entry into Qatar.

How to prove of residence: A resident card, utility bill, phone bill, credit/debit card bill, tenancy contract, and the official printed address page on passport.

### What documents are required? Required documents for an ETA are:

A copy of your valid passport containing two blank pages with at least 6 months validity from the date of entry into Qatar. If you are a resident or have a visa in a country that is on the visa waiver list, include a copy of that residence permit or visa.

A complete and correct visa application form. All the information presented must be up to date and must match the data on your passport.

Your accommodation information, such as a booking confirmation from your trip to Qatar. Please note, that you must have an accommodation booked.

Your return ticket information. Please note, that you must have a return or an onward ticket purchased. Once the requirements are met and you are sent an ETA, you are authorized to travel to Qatar and obtain a visa on arrival.

Required documents for a Tourist Visa:

A copy of your valid passport containing two blank pages with at least 6 months validity from the date of entry into Qatar as well as a personal photograph.

A complete and correct visa application form. All the information presented must be up to date and must match the data on your passport.

Your flight information, such as a booking confirmation from your trip to Qatar. Please note, that you must have tickets booked both ways.

The Tourist Visa to Qatar is applied online and you are requested to have a working e-mail address at all times. All the information about your e-Visa application will be sent to the e-mail you state in your application. You must pay for the visa online with a Visa or Mastercard.

Some countries have specific requirements and you should check your eligibility for a visa waiver. You can find all the needed information here.

There are a few steps to take and requirements to fill if you wish to visit Qatar in case your country is not included in the visa waiver list. The required documents are requested officially by the government of Qatar and iVisa is happy to help with the visa process. If you have a residence permit or a visa already to a country that is eligible for a visa waiver, you may apply for an ETA. If your country is not on the list at all, you must obtain an online visa.

#### How to apply for a Qatar from GCC Residents

#### Description:

The Ministry of Interior (MOI) issues this visa to GCC residents in authorized professions and their accompanying persons upon arriving at any port of entry to Qatar for visit or tourism purposes. The visa is valid for one month and it can be extended to a maximum of three months.

#### Online Instructions

- · Log in with your smartcard to MOI e-services portal.
- . Select "Visa Services", then "Issue Visa" and choose "Visit Visa for GCC Residents".
- Fill out the required information, such as name, birth date and place, passport details, phone number and address.
- Enter your email address, if you want to receive a soft copy of the visa application receipt.
- · Click on "Confirm" and pay appropriate fees to issue the visa.

#### Additional Information

- · The user shall own a smart card to use the service.
- The profession of the visitor shall be one of those accredited by the competent authority.
- The accompanying person shall be under the personal sponsorship of the resident and shall have a residence permit with three month validity.

#### Fees

- Visa issuance or monthly extension: QR100
- Visa issuance or monthly extension for accompanying person: QR50
- Fine for overstay per day: QR200
